COVID-19 UPDATE

COVID Update & Return to Work

Victoria has seen a reduction in positive COVID cases which is fantastic to see! Keep up the great work with staying safe at home, limiting your movements and when you do go out make sure you are safe with using your masks, social distancing and hand hygiene.

BIA's return to work date is still currently planned for Monday 14th September 2020. You will receive a phone call to confirm and your roster will be sent via SMS (text message). If you have not done so, please ensure you provide your mobile number to Nicole so you can receive your roster. Email nicole.featherstonehaugh@brunswickindustries.org.au

When you return, it is important that you continue to follow the COVID Safe Rules at work. If you can not follow these rules then you will be asked to stay at home!

1. If you feel unwell do NOT come to work. Please phone your GP and phone Reception on 9380 7444. If you have any of the following symptoms, you **MUST** stay home and get a COVID test, you are not to return to work until you have been tested and the result is negative:

Cold, Flu, Sore throat, Runny nose, Temperature.

2. You **MUST** wear a mask or a face covering of some sort. We can help you with how to use masks just ask one of your supervisors. Remember the mask must cover your nose & mouth see pictures.

If you have a medical exemption, then you are still required to wear a face shield. Ensure you change and or clean your masks!

3. If you are concerned about using public transport. Speak to a family member or your NDIS Support Coordinator or Local Area Coordinator about supports available for getting to and from work. BIA will support you with this.

4. Use the Hand Sanitiser upon arrival at Reception

5. Get your temperature checked

6. Use the Hand Sanitiser then clock on

7. Go straight to the locker room and wash your hands.

8. Keep 1.5 metres away from one another. (This is a minimum of two arm lengths)

9. Do not share food. Only bring/purchase your own food.

10. Continue to wash your hands and use hand sanitiser throughout the day!

Examples of Face Coverings you can wear at work



Disposable Masks.

These **MUST** be disposed of in the waste bin correctly. They **MUST** be changed regularly to new masks. Each day, after going to the toilet, after having a cigarette and or after breaks.



Reuseable – material made masks.

These **MUST** be fully washed each day.

Scarf or Bandana

These **MUST** be washed each day.



Face Shield

These are only if you have a medical exemption. You **MUST** wear this to attend work at BIA as per our COVID Safe Plan Policy.
